Roberta "Bobbi" Smith graduated from Ohio University with a B.S. in Textiles and Clothing with a specialization in Fashion Merchandising. She went on to study graduate coursework in Apparel Technology at the University of North Carolina and completed a certificate program in Industry Fashion Methods from Philadelphia University. Bobbi is also a Certified Sewing Educator by the American sewing Association and a licensed Viking Martha Pullen Heirloom Teacher.

Highlights of her career include volunteer work with The Carnegie Museum of Pittsburgh restoring the angels for their Neapolitan Presepio exhibit, a 17th century crèche scene. Bobbi designed and built a blue cloth jacket for the Peter Rabbit topiary, part of an Easter exhibit for Phipps Conservatory. She rebuilt the Christmas tree for the Pittsburgh Ballet's production of The Nutcracker. She has worked in the costume shop for many of the productions for the Pittsburgh Public Theatre including world premieres of August Wilson, a beloved playwright from Pittsburgh, PA. She has stitched costumes for the Wilmington Ballet's production of The Nutcracker and continues to dress and sew for the Broadway musicals coming into The Playhouse on Rodney Square in Wilmington De. She has been a dresser and a member of IATSE for over 25 years first in local 787 in Pittsburgh, PA and for the last 18 years in local 284 in Wilmington, DE.

For the past 11 years Bobbi has been teaching sewing in the After School Programs of Tower Hill, Wilmington Friends, Ursuline Academy, and Wilmington Christian Academy. She has taught in the New Castle Activity Centers and was a past faculty and Board member of Darlington Arts Center. She was a Girl Scout facilitator in the Girl Scouts of Eastern Pa council. She spends summers running her "Get Creative and Sew" Camps teaching a wide variety of sewing curriculum.
